



Dr Grigorios Liantas (1971, Assistant Professor in Interorthodox, Interchristian Relations and Ecclesiastical Policy at the University Ecclesiastical Academy of Thessalonica, Greece) studied theology in the Faculty of Theology at the Aristotle University of Thessalonica, where he received his doctorate (2005), and law in the Department of Law at Democritus University of Thrace.
